

## **COPR Entry to Practice Examination Eligibility Confirmation**

Most Canadian regulators require applicants for licensure/certification/registration (hereinafter referred to as “license”) to have successfully completed an entry to practice examination and license within one year of graduating from an approved course of study.

To be eligible to write the COPR entry to practice examination, **the examination date must be less than one (1) year from the date of educational program graduation.** Based on provincial regulator requirements, the following exceptions are permitted:

- Alberta: You have a valid provisional practice permit. **Instructions:** Complete section A of this form and ask the Alberta College of Paramedics to complete Section B. Upload the completed form to the examination application via the COPR applicant portal.
- Saskatchewan: You meet the requirement to write the examination within two (2) years of completing the educational program. **Instructions:** Complete section A of this form and ask the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics to complete Section B. Upload the completed form to the examination application via the COPR applicant portal.
- Manitoba: You meet the requirement to write the examination within eighteen (18) months of completing the educational program. **Instructions:** Complete section A of this form and ask the College of Paramedics of Manitoba to complete Section B. Upload the completed form to the examination application via the COPR applicant portal.
