

## Annual Educational Program Results for

### First-time COPR Entry to Practice Examination Candidates

This chart displays pass rates for the five Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) examinations administered in 2025. Annual pass rates include all first-time EMR examination candidates from Canadian educational institutions. The national examination total includes all first-time candidates, whereas the chart displays only those institutions or campuses with six or more candidates\*.

COPR reports institutional or campus-level data in accordance with educational institution requests; as a result, some institutions are reported as a single entity rather than broken down by individual campus.
